

DANCE POWER COMPETITION MARKS 2007

Please note: Dance Power is a 1st, 2nd, 3rd Competition

Therefore when there are more than 3 dances in a category only the top 3 finishes receive a placement
1st - gold, 2nd – silver and 3rd- bronze.

Each Division also is defined by years of training with the exception of Division I.

Division I – 0-2 years of dance training **or** maximum two hours/week :

: 80% Gold

Division II – 3-5 years of dance training :

: 83% Gold

Division III 6+ years of training :

: 85% Gold

This means that dancers who train 10 hours /week compete directly with dancers who dance 2.5 hours/week. In Calgary there are many studios where the dancers take 4-8 classes/week. With only one dance in a category you do not automatically get first, only if you achieve a gold standard for your division do you get first. Therefore a dancer in Division II with no other competitors who receives 82.83% does not receive 1st and a Gold, but rather 2nd and a Silver.

There is no rounding up of percentages.

The teachers were pleased with the effort by the dancers in Dance Power.
